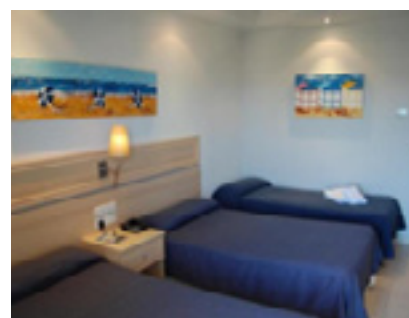
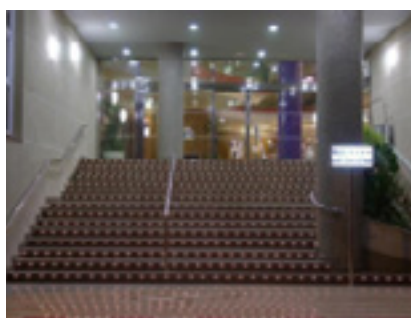

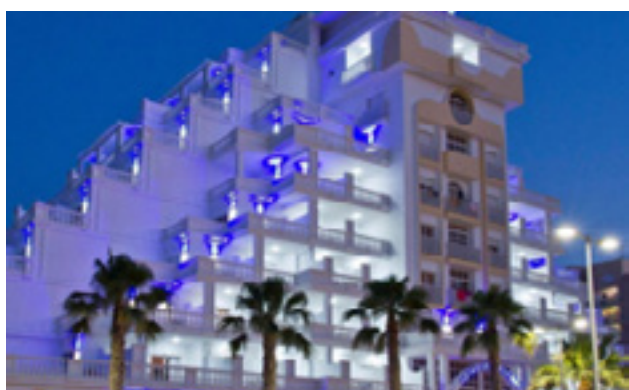
The hotels are located 130 km from Alicante airport and 42 km from San Javier airport, Murcia (direct connection with Brussels and Eindhoven).
